Dear Secretary Bose:

On behalf of Appalachian Power Company (Appalachian), enclosed for filing are one (1) original and two (2) copies of London/Marmet and Winfield Hydroelectric Projects, FERC Project Nos. 1175 and 1290, Integrated Licensing Process, Pre-Application Document, Volume II. This filing is being done simultaneously with the filing of the Notice of Intent to File Application for New License and the Pre-Application Document (PAD) Volume I for the London/Marmet Project No. 1175, and in accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 5.6 and § 388.112.

We believe that the enclosed documents contain Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII) as defined under 18 C.F.R. § 388.113. Therefore, we are requesting that all of the information contained in Volume II of the PAD be treated as CEII in accordance with the appropriate rules and regulations of the Commission for such information. Volume II of the PAD presents detailed information regarding the physical composition, dimensions, and general configuration of the dams, powerhouses, spillways and other components for the London/Marmet Project. In addition, information regarding the electrical systems for the project is provided in Volume II of the PAD. The information provided in Volume II relates to the production, generation, transmission, transportation, or distribution of energy and could be useful to a person in planning an attack on critical infrastructure. Therefore, a copy of this letter only is being provided to the participants in the relicensing process to give notice of the filing made.

The procedure for the general public to access the information contained in Volume II of the PAD for the London/Marmet Project are outlined in the <u>Information Distribution Protocol</u> contained in Volume I of the PAD that is being filed under separate cover simultaneously with this filing.

We believe that this filing is timely and has been prepared in accordance with the requisite rules and regulations governing such a filing. Any questions regarding the information included in this filing should be directed to the undersigned.
