Dear Secretary Bose:

On behalf of Appalachian Power Company (Appalachian), enclosed for filing are one (1) original and eight (8) copies of Notice of Intent to File Application for New License for the Winfield Project No. 1290 located on the New River in southwestern Virginia. The enclosed notice is being filed with the Commission pursuant to the requirements of 18 C.F.R. Section 5.5 and Subpart T of Part 385.

At this time, Appalachian is requesting to be designated as the Commission's non-Federal representative for purposes of consultation under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act and the joint agency regulations thereunder at 50 C.F.R. Part 402, section 305(b) of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act and the implementing regulations at 50 C.F.R. § 600.920. At this time, Appalachian is also requesting permission to initiate Section 106 consultation pertaining to the relicensing of the Winfield Project No. 1290 on behalf of the Commission in order to initiate consultation with the West Virginia State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and other consulting parties, pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 800.2(c)(4) of the regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

We believe that this filing is timely and has been prepared in accordance with the requisite rules and regulations governing such a filing. Any questions regarding the information included in this filing should be directed to the undersigned.

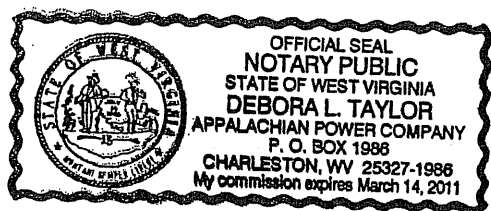
